**Midterm/Final:** The midterm and final are timed and consist mostly of multiple choice questions. Although, they may include problems that will be completed using excel. Counterintuitively, the midterm and final can be found under the “quiz” section in Canvas.

**Extra Credit:** Extra credit will be given for insightful questions and responses in the discussion board. Students are encouraged to ask the class for additional explanations for clarification.
