

## **Rutgers Bachelor of Arts in Business Administration (BBA) at Rowan College at Burlington County Recommended Transfer Courses**

For students interested in transferring into the Bachelor of Arts Business Administration degree offered by Rutgers at Rowan College at Burlington County (RCBC), the following RCBC courses are transferrable and are recommended to be completed before enrollment in the BBA:

ECO 203 – Principles of Microeconomics  
ECO 204 – Principles of Macroeconomics  
ACC 110 – Principles of Accounting I  
MTH 143 – Statistics I  
CIS 161 – Computer Applications  
BUA 205 – Business Law

The above courses should be completed as part of or in addition to an Associate degree program. Completion of an Associate of Arts (AA) or an Associate of Science (AS) degree is **required** to be considered for admission into the BBA program. The Associate of Science in Business Administration degree is the recommended associate degree program at RCBC, which includes most of the above courses as part of that program.

Please note: Students completing an Associate in Applied Science (AAS) degree are not eligible to transfer into the Business Administration degree program.

Students may transfer up to 60 credits from a community college to Rutgers School of Business–Camden and must receive a grade of C or better for a course to be transferred in. A minimum cumulative 2.5 GPA is recommended to be considered for admission.

For students who have not completed the Associate of Science (AS) degree in Business Administration at RCBC, it is recommended to consult with a Rutgers Off-Campus BBA Manager prior to applying to transfer to discuss transfer eligibility.

Courses for the Rutgers BBA degree at RCBC are a combination of courses taught in-class at the RCBC campus and online courses. Students interested in transferring into this program should be comfortable with taking online courses.
