Rutgers Bachelor of Arts in Business Administration (BBA) at Rowan College of South Jersey-Gloucester Recommended Transfer Courses

For students interested in transferring into the Bachelor of Arts Business Administration degree offered by Rutgers at Rowan College of South Jersey-Gloucester (RCSJ), the following RCSJ courses are transferrable and are recommended to be completed before enrollment in the BBA:

ECO 101 – Principles of Economics I ECO 102 – Principles of Economics I BUS 103 – Accounting II MAT 103 – Statistics CIS 102 – Introduction to Computers BUS 107 – Business Law I

The above courses should be completed as part of or in addition to an Associate degree program. Completion of an Associate of Arts (AA) or an Associate of Science (AS) degree is **required** to be considered for admission into the BBA program. The Associate of Science in Business Administration degree is the recommended associate degree program at RCSJ, which includes most of the above courses as part of that program.

Please note: Students completing an Associate in Applied Science (AAS) degree are not eligible to transfer into the Business Administration degree program.

Students may transfer up to 60 credits from a community college to Rutgers School of Business–Camden and must receive a grade of C or better for a course to be transferred in. A minimum cumulative 2.5 GPA is recommended to be considered for admission.

For students who have not completed the Associate of Science (AS) degree in Business Administration at RCSJ, it is recommended to consult with a Rutgers Off-Campus BBA Manager prior to applying to transfer to discuss transfer eligibility.

Courses for the Rutgers BBA degree at RCSJ are a combination of courses taught in-class at the RCSJ campus and online courses. Students interested in transferring into this program should be comfortable with taking online courses.
