Rutgers School of Business-Camden Accelerated Dual Degree Bachelor of Science/Online Master of Accountancy (BS/Online MAcc) Program

The Accelerated Dual Degree BS/Online MAcc Program at Rutgers School of Business–Camden (RSBC) offers highly motivated Accounting undergraduates an opportunity to accelerate their Online Master of Accountancy studies and qualify for the 150 credit hour CPA certification requirement in conjunction with the completion of their undergraduate degree.

This innovative program allows undergraduates to enroll in undergraduate and graduate coursework concurrently during their senior year. In addition to fulfilling the CPA credit hour requirement, highlights of the program include:

- An Accounting curriculum that prepares students for the current job market
- Courses taught by highly qualified Rutgers Accounting faculty and Industry Professionals
- 100% online coursework - allows you to work full-time or participate in an internship

Students apply for program admission in the spring semester of their junior year and, if admitted, begin graduate work in the fall of their senior year. *While enrolled as a full-time undergraduate in the senior year (fall and spring), a Dual Degree student also enrolls in 6 credits (2 courses) of graduate coursework at no additional cost; 3 credits in the fall and 3 credits in the spring.*

At the end of the senior year, the student earns a bachelor's degree. The student completes the remaining 24 credits of graduate coursework to earn the Online Master of Accountancy degree one year after earning the bachelor's degree.

Qualification Checklist for Dual-Degree Program

Eligible Applicants must:

- ✓ Be a matriculating RSBC undergraduate student pursuing a Bachelor of Science in Accounting
- ✓ Have and maintain a cumulative GPA of at least 3.00 at the point of their application submission and through degree completion
- ✓ Have completed Intermediate Accounting I with a minimum grade of "C" or better
- ✓ Have earned approximately 90 credits by the end of junior year (including applicable transfer credits)
- ✓ Maintain full-time undergraduate status during the fall and spring semesters of the senior year
- ✓ Successfully complete the BS in Accounting

Pre- Application and Course Enrollment Process

Step 1: *Submit the following to Amelia Nowak, Student Counselor, Graduate Programs:*

- Accelerated Dual-Degree BS/Online MAcc Program Pre-Application (below)
- Senior Review (Curriculum Worksheet (<https://business.camden.rutgers.edu/ug/worksheets/>) signed by RSBC undergraduate advisor)
- Unofficial Rutgers Transcript (include non-Rutgers transcripts or Transfer Summary Report, as applicable)
- Current Resume

Step 2: If pre-admitted, candidate will meet with the Student Counselor, Graduate Programs to discuss the formal application process, course enrollment, and academic planning, including the following:

- Review the Online MAcc course schedule and related costs
- Enroll in Online MAcc courses *

*Note: The two online MAcc courses taken as an undergraduate student **only** count towards the MAcc degree. However, the grades in those two courses will be calculated into both the undergraduate and graduate GPA.

After Receiving Pre-Admission to the Dual Degree Program

Admitted Student Process (SENIOR with 90+ credits completed):

Senior Undergraduates must:

- Maintain full-time undergraduate enrollment status (12 credits in fall and spring semester) in the senior year.
- Enroll in no more than three (3) credits or one Online MAcc course in each semester of their senior year (fall/spring).
- Submit the online undergraduate diploma application for degree conferral in final semester of the undergraduate program.

Official Admission Application and Matriculation in the MBA Program

Required Matriculation to the Online Master of Accountancy program (complete by end of SENIOR year):

- Admission to the Online MAcc program is NOT GUARANTEED by pre-admission through the Dual Degree Program.
- Complete online Graduate Admission Application: [2022 Application Portal - Rutgers University \(force.com\)](https://force.com).
 - Submit all required documents within applicable graduate admission deadline, including:
 - Standardized test scores (GMAT or GRE) *
 - 2 letters of recommendation
 - Resume
 - Personal statement
 - **The application fee will be waived for current Rutgers students.**

*Applicants with exceptional work experience and exceptional academic record may request a waiver of standardized exam scores. To find out if you qualify for an Exam Waiver, go to: [GMAT Waiver - Rutgers School of Business - Camden](#).

- **In the Online MAcc program:**
 - The graduate tuition rate will be charged.
 - No more than **two grades of "C"** applied toward degree completion.
 - Matriculated student must complete the program in one calendar year.
